The Centre for Development Initiatives (CDI) invites applications for its Community Development Project in Guwahati, Assam. The project aims to initiate work with children, women and vulnerable households, provide access to welfare rights and entitlements, and conduct an intensive survey for need assessment for vulnerable households in the informal settlements under Bhootnath Cluster such as Bagan, Dolki, Namghar, Tokobari, Kamakhya Railway Line, Mela Tenki, Santipur Rail Line and other settlements that CDI may extend to.

1) Name of the Position: Community Mobiliser

No. of Posts: 04

Role: A motivated and community-oriented Community Mobiliser to engage with residents in informal settlements, build strong community relationships, identify eligible beneficiaries, and facilitate their participation in project activities.

Eligibility:

- Graduate. Preferably in Social Work, Sociology, Rural Development, or a related field.
- Experience in community outreach, mobilization, or development programs is desirable.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Ability to work independently in field settings.
- Fluency in Assamese and Hindi is desirable.
- Applicants residing in the above-mentioned settlements under Bhootnath Cluster are preferred in order to facilitate regular community engagement and field visits.

Remuneration:

Rs.18,000 per month. Non-negotiable.

2) Position: Children Learning Centre Coordinator

No. of Posts: 08

Role: Responsible for managing and overseeing the daily operations of the Children Learning Centres, ensuring a safe, inclusive, and child-friendly learning environment. The role includes facilitating learning activities, supporting the academic and holistic development of children, coordinating with parents and community members, maintaining centre records, and ensuring the effective implementation of programme activities.



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Eligibility:

- Graduate (preference may be given to candidates with a background in Education, Social Work, Child Development, or related fields).
- Fluency in Assamese, Hindi and English is desirable.

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3) Position: Children Outreach Worker

Role: Responsible for community-level engagement to identify, reach, and support vulnerable children in informal settlements. The role includes conducting outreach activities, home visits, and community awareness sessions, following up with irregular or out-of-school children, engaging with families to encourage children's participation in programme activities and maintaining regular field documentation to support effective project implementation.

Eligibility:

- Graduate. Candidates who have passed Class 12 (Higher Secondary) with relevant experience in community outreach, child protection, education, or social development are also encouraged to apply.
- Fluency in Assamese and Hindi is desirable.
- Applicants residing in the above-mentioned settlements under Bhootnath Cluster are preferred in order to facilitate regular community engagement and field visits.
